

Sunday	The Lord's Day
God worked on Sunday Genesis 1:1-5	God rested on the seventh day – God's rest day or Sabbath
God commanded work on Sunday Exodus 20:8-11	God blessed and sanctified (made holy) the Sabbath
God calls it a working day Ezekiel 46:1	God commanded "Remember the Sabbath day to keep it holy" Exodus 20:8
God never blessed Sunday	The Sabbath was made before sin, hence it is not a type
Christ did not rest upon it	The Sabbath was made for man and all mankind Mark 2:27
Sunday was never sanctified	It was made 2,500 years before there was a Jew.
The New Testament nowhere forbids work on it	The Bible never calls it a "Jewish Sabbath"
There was no penalty for its desecration	God placed it in the centre of His ten moral commandments
No blessing promised for its observance	The Sabbath was commanded by the voice of the living God
No regulation given as to how it should be observed	God wrote the Commandments with His own finger on stone
It is never called the "Christian Sabbath"	God pronounced a special blessing on Gentiles who keep the Sabbath Isaiah 56:3,5,6
It is never called the "Lord's Day"	God promises to bless any man who will keep the Sabbath
No sacred title is applied to it	After the Sabbath has been trodden down for "many generations" it is to be restored in the last days Isaiah 58:12,13
The word "Sunday" never occurs in the Word of God	The Sabbath is the "Lord's Day" Mark 2:28; Isaiah 58:13; Exodus 20:8-11
Neither God, Christ, or any inspired man ever said one word in favour of Sunday as a holy day	Gentile converts called it "the Sabbath" 14 years after the cross Acts 13:42
There was no requirement to break bread on Sunday	Three decades after the cross, the Bible says the Sabbath remaineth Hebrews 4:9
The Bible nowhere says the first day of the week commemorates the resurrection of Christ	Christians are to enter Sabbath rest as God did Hebrews 4:10
This is a tradition of men which makes void the commandment of God	Everyone in the New Earth will keep the Sabbath Isaiah 66:22,23
